#### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

Instituto de Lenguas has been teaching Spanish to students sessions available: from all over the world since 1993. They pride themselves on a friendly and relaxed study atmosphere, and do their best to make 17.30(5:30PM); 17.30(5:30PM)-19.00(7:00PM) each student's time with them as fun as it is rewarding.

San Cristóbal de las Casas, with a population of 100,000, lies in the southern Mexican state of Chiapas, high in the mountains surrounded by pine forests. With its cobblestone streets and its red-tile roofs, San Cristóbal is a mix of 16th century Spanish influences and a vivid, colorful indigenous culture. Beautiful churches, cathedrals and buildings abound, along with the largest indigenous market in northern America where the indigenous the full 15 hours per week with a Tutor. people from surrounding villages come daily to sell their fruits, vegetables and crafts.

The climate in San Cristobal is particular to its region. May to October, the climate is mild with usual sunny days, but rainy afternoons. October to May, beautiful, sunny and warm days are common, with the nights being clear and chilly.

#### **ABOUT THE PROGRAMS**

Instituto de Lenguas specializes in Tutor one-on-one Spanish instruction. As a result, their Spanish classes are set up to accommodate individual learning styles, personal interests and preferences. In order to accommodate a variety of student needs, the school doesn't use one particular textbooks for all students. A variety of textbooks, exercises, books and other learning materials are used. The school does not have a set policy for homework, students do as much as they wish, in agreement with teachers.

hours per day of two 1.5 hour sessions of private one-on-one instruction. Students are encouraged to study with two different teachers daily, as different teachers use different materials and have different styles of instruction. However if the student would like to have just one instructor, the school is happy to arrange that.

Lessons can be scheduled with some flexibility, depending on availability. A student may either take three hours of instruction together, or may have one and half hours in the morning, then have a break, and then have another one and a half hour session later in the day. The school requests that each student define

If you enroll and pay for a Group Program and there is no other student at your same level who is enrolled in the Group Program upon your arrival, you have two options:

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

Homestays Contact with the local people of San Cristobal de Las Casas is an invaluable part of learning Spanish, and homestay accommodation provides students with firsthand experience of daily life, and enables them to practice Spanish. Each student is provided with a private room, usually sharing the bathroom with the host family. 3 meals daily are also provided. All host families are within walking distance from the center of town. The school places just one student per family so there is maximum exposure to the language. However, if you prefer to live with another student, the school is happy to arrange that on request.

#### **SPECIAL ACTIVITIES**

Instituto de Lenguas is happy to help you plan day trips to the surrounding villages and archeological sites, and also weekend trips to the jungle or to Palengue, visiting waterfalls and going on boat tours. Just ask!
