## INSTITUTO DE LENGUAS - MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY

### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

The NRCSA Center in Montevideo is housed in a renovated two story building. The first floor facilities include the reception area, administrative offices, four large classrooms, a library, a fully equipped kitchen, a living and dining room area with a television, an outside terrace, and a yard where students can spend their breaks, meet after class and take part in the Friday night barbecues. The second floor of the building contains the student residence.

**Montevideo** the capital of Uruguay, is located on the Rio de la Plata on the southern most tip of the country's South Atlantic coast. It is a modern metropolis of a million and a half inhabitants and the city is the seat of important national and international events. The main attractions are the ramblas (boulevards) that follow the beautiful and lengthy shoreline which are, without a doubt, one of the finest luxuries of the city. Montevideo's European influence is evident, as it stretches along avenues, boulevards and tree-lined streets on which modern buildings are being erected alongside buildings of days long past, a testimony to the different periods of the city's history.

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

#### Intensive Course

Group 20 hours per week. The Intensive Course consists of four lessons daily incorporating grammar, conversation and practical application of Spanish. There is a maximum of 8 students per class and each lesson has a duration of 55 minutes. Classes are held in the mornings.

#### Superintensive Course

Group 30 hours per week. The Superintensive Course consists of six lessons daily incorporating the same elements of the Intensive Course but with more focus on conversation and practical application of Spanish. There is a maximum of 6 students per class and each lesson has a duration of 55 minutes. Classes are held in the mornings.

#### Intensive Plus Tutor Course

Group/Tutor 25 hours per week: 20 hours Group + 5 hours Tutor. The Intensive Plus Tutor Course combines four lessons daily of the Intensive Course with two lessons daily of private tutorial lessons which are adapted to the needs of the student. Each lesson has a duration of 55 minutes. Group classes are held in the mornings while the Tutor classes take place in the afternoons.

#### Tutor Course

20 hours per week. The Tutor course consists of four lessons daily adapted to the specific and individual needs of the student. Each lesson has a duration of 55 minutes and are held either in the mornings or afternoons.

### Children's Group Course

8 - 15 years. 15 hours per week. This is a special course for children aged 8 through 15 years. It consists of three lessons daily incorporating basic grammar, conversation and educational games. There is a maximum of 6 students per class and each lesson has a duration of 55 minutes.

Please Note: Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Course is offered all year-round, however, there may not be other children attending at certain times of the year.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

#### Student Residence

The student residence is located on the second floor of the school building itself. There are four big bedrooms suitable for two persons with students sharing one bathroom in the hall. Three of these rooms have two single beds and one has one double bed. There is also an additional bedroom with two beds available with its own private bath with jacuzzi. Bed linen and towels are provided and cleaned weekly. Laundering of clothes can be provided by the cleaning person once per week for a small fee.

#### Homestays

Living with a local family encourages practice of the language and enriches the cultural knowledge of the student. Carefully selected families are chosen who are sympathetic to those students who want to learn more about the Uruguayan culture and way of life. Students are treated as a member of the family. Students are provided a single room with 2 meals daily while sharing the bath with the other members of the family. Bed linen and towels are provided and cleaned weekly.

#### Apartments & Small Houses

Accommodation in an apartment or small house can be arranged. Most are usually about 50 meters from the beach in a quiet area of town. One, two and three bedrooms are available on request and at additional cost.

#### Hotel

We can arrange for the student to stay in a small hotel situated on the beach front. Rooms are comfortable and all have a private bath. This option is available on request and at an additional cost.
