

## CELA - AVIGNON, FRANCE

### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

**CELA** - we specialize in linguistics and the teaching of conversational French. Founded in 1980, CELA is a nonprofit organization whose principal purpose is the teaching of French as a foreign language, incorporating the latest research in the field of linguistics. The Centre is located in the heart of the city near the Pope's Palace.

Enthusiastic teachers, pragmatic methodology and the natural resources of the area combine to make this an outstanding learning center. CELA operates all year long and among its activities offers various courses of study.

The city of Avignon, the province of the Vaucluse and the region of Provence provide rich history, art and landscape in an ideal climate. Avignon, a maze of ramparts, machicolated towers, belfries and palaces, is the sort of city seen in ancient woodcuts or medieval tapestries. The formidable palace-fortress was built for the Popes who, during a century of residence in Avignon (1309-1403) gave the town its monumental appearance. Avignon today is the setting for an international festival, which is an important annual event (July) in European theatre.

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

#### French Language & Civilization Course

Conversation classes of 4 hours daily, 8:30 -12:30 or 14:00 - 18:00, and focus on practical use of the everyday language. Dialogues for beginners are structured on family living and basic necessities such as food, clothing, banking, etc. As the student progresses, dialogues emphasize French culture and current events - with guided discussions based on newspaper articles, radio/TV, movies, plays, etc. Wherever possible, the specific vocabulary needs of each individual student are met. Daily reading, writing and grammar exercises supplement conversation classes based on student levels and needs. Classes average 5-8 students - with the maximum class size being 12 students. Students are grouped in one of 5 or 6 levels, beginner to advanced.

#### Tutor Course

10 hours per week. The course involves 2 hours each day with a teacher who develops a plan of study corresponding to the needs of the student. The teacher and student also plan the other work, such as analysis of oral, written and video documents, and activities such as visits to various organizations and institutions, contacts with French people, excursions, working dinners, etc.

#### Language & Cooking Course

Intermediate level required. Learn French and the art of French cuisine. The first week of every month, CELA offers the opportunity for an exploration into the cuisine of Provence by bringing in special guests, such as renowned chefs, restaurant owners and local wholesale producers. The program consists of

the general French language program at 20 hours per week plus 5 hours per week of cooking and cuisine.

#### Christmas Course

All levels are welcome in CELA's Christmas Course. This one week program is held the week before Christmas and combines French language study with an exploration of the holiday cultural traditions of Provence.

#### Special Group Programs

The region of Avignon is an excellent resource area. As a result, CELA has been most active in coordinating programs for groups interested in language, art, film, theatre, literature, education, medicine, journalism, sociology, music, agriculture, and related fields. ### ACCOMMODATIONS

#### Homestays

Families are carefully selected by the school and offer a variety of meal plans in a hospitable environment.

#### Apartments

For students and families staying a month or longer, there are a few studios and apartments. However, they must be reserved far in advance and require full prepayment which is not refundable if they do not suit your tastes.

Hotels can also be arranged on request.

### SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

CELA's staff recommends the pursuit of vocational, hobby or recreational interests and involvement in the local community. They are happy to provide lists of area resources and/or make appointments in the event you wish to accomplish projects or research, i.e. business school or club visits, meetings with teachers, artists, social workers, local students, attend university lectures or meetings, etc.
