#### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

French Language School is a member of The International House World Organization and schools are maintained through a rigorous code of practice and regular inspection. IH Nice is located right in the centre of the city, with 9 classrooms, hightech audio-visual and computer equipment. All IH Nice teachers are native French speakers with higher education qualifications.

Nice, the capital of the Riviera, is blessed with an exceptional location. By train or car it is just 20 minutes away from the famous seaside resorts of Antibes, Juan-les-Pins, Cannes or Monaco and Monte-Carlo, and situated at the heart of the Baie des Anges with its seven kilometres of beaches.

#### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

Intensive Combined Program Group/Tutor 30 hrs/wk: 25 hours Group + 5 hours Tutor, Intensive Combined program consists of group French study and tailor-made individual classes. Classes are held Monday - Friday, morning Group class and afternoon Tutor class.

Intensive Individual Program 25 hrs/wk Tutor. This very intensive program. Special emphasis and vocabulary in business, commercial, legal, medical, diplomatic, etc. are available. Classes are held Monday - Friday, 9.00 to 13.05 (subject to season).

#### **Business French Program - July and August Only**

31 hrs/wk: 25 hours Group + 6 hours Business French. This program combines morning classes of General French with afternoon classes in Business French. Classes are held Monday -Friday, 9.00 to 13.05 + three days per week 14.15 to 15.55.

Senior Program 2 weeks, 20+ hrs/wk. Specifically designed for students over 50 years, this program combines French language classes in the morning, 9.00 to 12.00, with organized social and cultural activities in the afternoon, Monday - Friday.

French & Fine Arts Program 2, 4 or 6 weeks, 37 hrs/wk: 25 hours Group French + 12 hours Fine Art. All Levels Accepted. This program combines 25 hours per week of French study in a group setting, 9.00 to 13.05 Monday - Friday, with fine arts classes three afternoons per week. Drawing, painting, illustration, plastic arts, colour, volume, etc.

French & Design Program 5 or 10 weeks, 37 hrs/wk: 25 hours Group French + 12 hours Design. Intermediate Level Required. For students of Fashion Design, graphic arts and interior design. It combines 25 hours per week of French study, 9.00 to 13.05 Monday - Friday, with design classes three afternoons per week. French & Work Placement 8 weeks minimum: 4 weeks Group French OR Tutor French 25 hrs/wk + 4 weeks Work 20 hrs/wk. Elementary Level Required. Designed for students aged 20 to 30 years. Minimum of 4 weeks French language and minimum of 4

weeks work placement. The following areas are available: \* Hotel Industry \* Tourism \* Secretarial Fields \* Commercial Industry. Placement is unpaid.

French & Cuisine Program 2 weeks, 37 hrs/wk: 25 Group French + 12 Cuisine, All Levels Accepted. The program consists of 25 hours per week of French study in a group, 9.00 to 13.05 Monday - Friday, with six lessons French cuisine two afternoons per week, 16.00 to 18.15.

**DELF Examination Preparation Programs** The program is intended for students wishing to increase their efforts in preparing for the DELF exam, Diploma of French Language Studies delivered by the French Ministry of Education. It is composed of 25 hours per week of French study in a group, 9.00 to 13.05 Monday - Friday, with afternoon classes to prepare for the DELF, 14.15 to 15.55. Two levels of are offered.

Teen Program - Summer Only 15 - 17 years old, 20+ hrs/wk. No Beginners Accepted. The program cost includes 4 hours per day of French language, two afternoons per week of cultural activities, one full-day excursion, housing with a carefully selected host family and 3 meals daily, all materials, a study certificate, arrival and departure transfer.

All families live in Nice itself and are easily reached by bus, rarely more than 30 minutes away from the school on foot. A private room and breakfast daily are provided. Double rooms are available. Studios, Hotels & Residential Hotels are available.
