#### ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

Since its foundation in 1983, GSL Institue has become one of the leading teaching centers for German as a foreign language. Grand palaces, incomparable art museums like the Pergamon and the Bauhaus, innumerable restaurants, a vast and varied music scene and nightlife all make Berlin a unique destination for learning the German language.

#### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

All GSL Group courses consist of a maximum of 12 students per class and each class is 45 minutes in duration. The goal of each course is to improve the student's active and passive language ability and develop understanding of German culture and the German way of thinking. All courses are taught exclusively in German and are open to all levels. Students are obliged to attend all lessons on time. All students should bring a dictionary German/own language - own language/German, paper and pens/pencils. All other teaching material is provided by GSL.

Standard Course Group 20 hours per week. Lessons take place Monday to Friday from 9:15 to 12:30. Beginners must start on specified dates, while all other levels may start any Monday.

Intensive Course Group 30 hours per week. Students enrolled in this course participate in the Standard course in the morning along with additional lessons in the afternoons from 13:00 - 14:45 in a small group setting of a maximum of 6 students/class.

Tutor Course 20 hours per week. This course is designed for those students who need flexibility and intensity. Specific content and learning style are decided upon between teacher and student. Course begins any Monday for all levels.

12 Week Semester Courses Group 20 or 30 hours per week. These long term courses are designed for those students who want to gain deep knowledge of German and experience living in Germany, perhaps for their career of university studies. The courses last 12 weeks and are can be used as preparation for language examinations of the universities or the Goethe Institut.

International Summer Camp in Schmoeckwitz for Children & Teens - Ages 8-16.

GSLSprachenzentrum accomplishes a full immersion concept in language learning at their International Summer Camp for ages 8-16 years. The German program is based on 3 daily lessons of German in small classes. Participants live in 2 or 3 bedded rooms and each room has its own shower and WC. Three meals per

Summer Centre in Berlin for Teens - Ages 16-19.

GSL Sprachenzentrum also offers the Berlin Summer Centre for ages 16 - 19 years. Students have 20 weekly lessons of German on 4 different levels. Classes are internationally mixed. Students live in renovated and spacious 3 to 4 bedded rooms. There are several showers and WCs. Three meals per day are included.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

#### Homestays

Students are housed in the home of a German family. Some families have their own houses with a garden whereas some live in flats right in the center of the city. The guest-rooms may have double, or single beds. Normally there is only one bathroom which is shared; towels and bed linen are provided by the family. 2 meals daily are included in the host-family-accommodation. Shared Student Apartments & Hotels are also available.

#### **SPECIAL ACTIVITIES**

GSL Institue has a richly varied social and cultural program. All activities are accompanied by leaders specially trained by GSLand, as real Berliners, the leaders not only know all the tourist attractions the city offers, but they will also show students hidden parts and corners of Berlin, away from tourists trails
