City Information



Quito

the capital of Ecuador, has a population of approximately one and half million people. The city rises 2,850 meters (9,350 feet) above sea level, with an annual average temperature of 13C/55F. The dry season in Quito is May to October, and brief daily showers occur November through April. Nights are crisply cool, requiring a sweater or jacket, but the daytime temperatures, year round, rarely vary from the upper 60s to the low 70s F.

In addition to its gorgeous landscapes, surrounded by hills and several snowcapped volcanoes, Quito is well known for having a treasure of colonial buildings, paintings, sculptures and carvings. From Quito you can easily explore places such as the indigenous market in Otavalo, one of the largest on the continent. Another side trip might be to the hot springs gurgling from the base of a nearby volcano. Beaches are close, and the surf is great. Night life is very active, with salsa clubs and fine restaurants. The crime rate of Ecuador is lower than that of the United States. Quito is also a metropolitan city that offers almost unlimited opportunities for recreation, relaxation and learning.

The Program

The volunteer program is for people interested in learning about sustainable solutions to poverty. All volunteers will work in partnership with local people in a variety of community-based projects. This unique program offers exciting hands-on work opportunities, meaningful cultural immersion, and enriching language program.

The Program includes 20 hours per week of Group Spanish classes. Maximum number of students per class is 4, with the average being 2 students. Groups are organized in a way that each will always consist of students possessing the same level of Spanish. At the conclusion of your studies, you will receive a certificate of completion. The method is based on the 4 language skills: listening, grammar, oral and written comprehension. No English will be used in class.

Classes are 55 minutes in length. Students may enroll for as many weeks as desired. In order to make sufficient progress and gain the maximum benefit from the course, the following program duration ranges are recommended: Beginner (4-12 weeks), Intermediate (2-12 weeks) and advanced (2-12 weeks). Courses lasting for more than 3 months will require a visa from the Ecuadorian government.

On the first Monday, students are given a city tour and information about the city, school, family life and culture. No formal Spanish classes take place the student's first Monday.

Classes are held 8:00-10:20, break 10:20-10:50, and resume 10:50-12:50. Sometimes in high season classes may take place in the afternoon too. Teachers are rotated every week.

Lodging



Homestays The students host family is a wonderful support network. When the details of daily living are out of the way it frees the mind to learn Spanish. They provide breakfast and dinner, and do laundry.

Some families have more than one bedroom for couples and parents with children. All students have a private bath. Most families live within walking distance.



The NRCSA center

One of the school's goals is to provide excellence in education with emphasis on grammar and vocabulary. To insure students' success, high quality teaching materials authored by school staff are provided.

Professors have university degrees with experience in teaching Spanish to foreigners. Their wide variety of expertise includes Economics, Business Administration, History, Marketing, Literature, etc.

A Certificate which is recognized by the Ecuadorian Ministry of Education is awarded for all students who complete their program. In Germany, our center is recognized as Bildungsurlaub with lessons of 25 hours or more per week by the Freie Und Hansestandt Hamburg, Hessen and Berlin.

Recently, the school has hosted students from United States (39%), Germany (30%), Switzerland (8%), Austria (7%), Canada (5%), Brazil (4%), England (2%), France (2%), Belgium (2%), Denmark (1%) Finland (0,16%), Norway (0,16%), Sweden (0,16%), Italy (0,16%), and Singapore (0,16%). These students have included business persons, university students, airline employees, teachers, retirees, ecologists, engineers, doctors, secretaries, travel agents, bankers, lawyers, and others.

Housed in a beautiful new mansion, the school is surrounded by gardens in quiet residential area. There is complementary e-mail service at the school for the students (no access to the internet). However, there are several reasonably priced internet cafes close to the school and all over the city. Mail service, money exchange, safety box, luggage storage, and use of sports facilities are also included.

Activities

Excursions, Cultural & Social Activities

As part of the program, students will have the opportunity to learn about the country, its history, and the people. In addition to lectures, the school offers trips to places of interest such as museums, and a night at the folkloric ballet. Students can participate in as many activities as they like.

Organized trips or group activities are offered 1- 4 times per week. These provide a great opportunity to find out about the country and its culture. Trips are also organized to exciting destinations such as the Galapagos Islands, Cotopaxi and the rainforest. Every trip offered has been tried and tested by the school staff and any feedback from students who have participated is always take into account and acted upon. The school maintains a well-equipped library with updated maps and travel guides, which the students are free to use at any time in order to organize their individual travels.

Activities vary from week to week. Here is an example of some of the excursions:

Volunteer Programs in Ecuador

COMITE DEL PUEBLO: PARROQUIA SAN JOSÉ OBRERO

Objectives: The Comité de Pueblo was originally a communist commune set up in the 1970's but it has grown into a huge slum in the North of Quito housing over 70,000 of the city's poorest people. Many of the houses still lack electricity, heating and indoor plumbing. In the 1980's Padre Colin a Scottish missionary came over to Ecuador to try to help the people of the slum. Since his arrival he has built a church, a school with a school canteen to ensure that the children of the slum get at least one good meal a day, a library and a hospital with basic medical facilities for the inhabitants of the Comité.

All of these facilities lie on the outskirts of the slum. In addition he is currently engaged in a variety of projects to improve the living conditions of the people in the slum and try to ensure that they have access to clean water.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school

Eligibility: Undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: There are opportunities for volunteer work with the children of the Comité every afternoon, volunteers are needed to look after the children, help them with their homework and generally entertain them. This is an ideal volunteer placement for people with lots of imagination who can create entertainment for the children, with very few resources. Past volunteers have written and directed plays or set up art and craft sessions. The most important thing is to be enthusiastic and able to share your energy with these children who have nothing waiting for them when they go home to their houses in the slum.

Minimum work commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Intermediate. Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (two volunteers)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

Female Inmate Counselor CENTRO DE AYUDA EN LA CÁRCEL DE MUJERES

Objectives: The group was founded and is founded by a group of professional women to provide support and counseling for women with a variety of problems in jail.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: Depends on skills and experience. May involve a variety of tasks from administrative to direct support of counselors.

Minimum work commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Intermediate. Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program.

CHILDREN HOSPITAL

This is a hospital which houses the following centers:

- Child and Infant Nutritional Recuperation Center
- Center for children with cerebral paralysis
- Center for invalid adolescents

In addition, the hospital has the following facilities: Operating room, laboratories, diagnostic center, clinic, pharmacy, second hand clothing store, school for children with learning disabilities and physical handicaps, and various other projects.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: Volunteers can choose to work in the area that they are most interested in or where their skills can be put to best use. The work mainly involves spending time with and assisting in the care of the full time residents.

Minimum work commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Intermediate. Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (two volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals.

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

LA CALETA - HOME FOR CHILDREN

Objectives: Food, shelter, clothing, and education to poor children.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: Undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: Depends on skills and experience. May involve a variety of tasks from administrative to direct support of counselors.

Minimum Work Commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

Volunteer Programs in Ecuador

Medical

Objectives: This is a social medical program. The dispensario is run by a Catholic organization but the volunteers don't have to be Catholic or members of the organization to participate. The "Dispensario Don Bosco" houses the following: diagnostic clinic, pharmacy, second hand clothing store, school for children and various other projects.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: Volunteers can work in the area of most interest to them or where their skills are most needed. The work mainly involves spending time with and assisting in the care of the full-time residents of the home. You full or part-time schedule will be arranged on site as well as the area that you will work in.

Minimum Work Commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program.

FUNDACION DE SINDROME DE DOWN

Objectives: The "Fundacion de Sindrome de Down" is an institution made up of the ex-beauty Queens of the city of Quito, who on leaving their post, dedicate much of their time and energy to charitable projects to help the children of the city. There are a number of initiatives which the "FundaciUn" supports, for example, work with street children, work to improve the city of Quito and various other charitable projects. One project in particular is desperately in need of volunteers to work with Down Syndrome children.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Activities: In the mornings the children are divided into groups according to their mental abilities and volunteers are needed to work with them to improve their manual dexterity and help them to learn how to write or draw. In the afternoon the children receive individual therapy which concentrates on physical aspects of their development. Volunteers do not have to be physiotherapists, as the "FundaciUn" will provide training to teach them how to administer physical therapy to the children

Minimum Work Commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

HIJOS DE LOS PRESOS (CHILDREN OF PRISONERS)

Objectives: The Children of Prisoners is a home for children who have nowhere to go whilst their mothers are serving time in jail. The home provides them with some form of stability and a guarantee of food and a roof over their heads, until their mothers are released and they can return home. The children stay at the home for varying lengths of time but all of them are without parents and desperate for attention and love.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Requirements: To spend time with the children, play with them, help them with their homework. The most important thing that these children need is someone to care for them, to pay them attention and listen to what they have to say. The "Children of the Prisoners" desperately needs volunteers who can give a lot of love to children who need affection more than anything else in the world.

Minimum Work Commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals.

CENTRO LOS NIÑOS DE LA CALLE

Objectives: This is a private organization supported by UNESCO that provides counseling and support for street children and their families to enable the children to return home. The organization works within the public school system as well as directly with the children in the streets. They also provide temporary homes for the children. The Centro is located in the northern part of Quito.

Location: 15-20 minutes from our institute

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Responsibilities: There are two of positions available. Those with Social Work or Psychology specialization's can help the regular full time staff with counseling for the children. Those without specific qualifications can help in areas such as administration, homework, activities and general care of the children.

Minimum Work Commitment: 4 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals daily.

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

Volunteer Programs in Ecuador

Central University

Objectives: This is the biggest University in Ecuador (40,000 students). Our school is the formal extension of the Spanish department from Central University in Quito. The people are very helpful and willing to offer the best facilities for all foreign volunteers. At the end of the work the student will receive a formal certification as an Assistant Professor from Central University.

Responsibilities: English as a Second Language teacher responsible for planning and implementing classes as an English teacher assistant. Classes are taught 2-4 hours/day. Sessions run from: October to June. It is required to work a minimum of 2 months.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals daily.

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

ESCUELA MUSHAC PACARI

Objectives: This is a small school located 6 miles outside of Quito. The children need psychological support, love and attention because most of them don't have their parents since they immigrated to Spain or Italy. The school has the support of their families living abroad and with small resources they were able to make the institution great. The school is very helpful and willing to offer as much help to all foreign volunteers.

Activities: Social workers, English as a second language, art or math teachers are needed. They are responsible for planning and implementing classes for students of various ages and abilities. Classes are taught 2-4 hours/day. Sessions run from: October to June but it is not a requirement to work the whole year.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Responsibilities: English as a Second Language teacher responsible for planning and implementing classes for girls of various ages and abilities. Classes are taught 2-4 hours/day. Sessions run from: October to June but it is not a requirement to work the whole year.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals daily.

Student Services Coordinator

Nature of the Institution: Our institution which teaches Spanish as a foreign language, in addition to organizing various cultural activities for the students during their stay in the city of Quito.

Responsibilities: Student services coordinator position available for a well organized dynamic person. This is a very popular program, which means that there is a lot of work to be done. Volunteers will be involved in a variety of tasks from translations, international correspondence, organization of cultural activities, and special projects.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Volunteer Programs in Ecuador

WALL STREET INSTITUTE SCHOOL OF ENGLISH

Nature of the Institution: WSI is an English teaching institute with over 450 centres around the world in over 30 countries, teaching almost one million students world wide. Established over two years ago in Ecuador, has grown from having one centre in Quito, to having 4 centres in Quito, 1 in Guayaquil, 1 in Manta and one in Cuenca. Our students must be at least 17 years old to study in any of our centres. Mostly young professionals and college students.

Responsibilities: We are looking for a part-time or full time teacher with some experience in teaching, although not necessary since WSI has its own teaching method. Our teachers must be willing to rotate schedules; one day morning and afternoon, and another afternoon and evening.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals daily.

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

SALA DE ARTES KINGMAN OR GUAYASAMÍN

Nature of the Institution: A privately funded art museum located in the commercial part of Quito. It promotes understanding and knowledge of modern art. The exhibits are mainly works by Guayasamin and Kingman. There is also a section displaying pre-Inca works. Guided tours are offered as well as art related lectures.

Responsibilities: Those volunteers who are professional artists can give art classes to children and adults, other volunteers are needed to talk about art to children and encourage their participation in museum activities. Translators are needed for correspondence and logging from the guest book. Also, help is needed in recruiting and training local volunteers.

Location: Quito, Ecuador. 20-25 minutes from the school.

Eligibility: undergraduate, graduate students and adults with an undergraduate degree or higher.

Guidelines: Volunteer positions on a space available basis. These are unpaid positions.

Minimum Work Commitment: 8-12 weeks

Level in the language: Beginner and Post Beginner level in Spanish must take 4 weeks pre course prior to beginning volunteer work.

Schedule: Varies approximately 10-20 hours per week in the afternoon.

Capacity: (one volunteer)

Lodging: Homestay, single room and 2 meals daily.

Other: Please register at least 40 days prior to the starting date of the program. Also, we do not know if position is available until you apply.

At A Glance - Quito, Ecuador

General

- No maximum age. Minimum age is 17 for Adult Programs (often waived if accompanied by an adult) and 14 for Summer Teen Program.
- Location: Downtown
- Size: varies considerably by season. The 'average' is under 25 foreign students.
- Medical: school refers students if needed (medical costs additional). See below for information regarding insurance.
- Arrival airport transfers are included if flights advised 30 days prior arrival.
- Vacations: no class make-up on National, Regional & local holidays.

Classes

- Foreign language classes are taught entirely in the foreign language (immersion method).
- All levels are welcome (beginner to advanced) unless otherwise specified above.
- Levels: placement tests are used. If there is no full group at your level, smaller group or tutor may be given with fewer hours per week.
- Tutor means one-on-one class (private teacher). Shared tutor means two-on-one.
- Students/class is maximum people per class ... which may be exceeded by 1-2 persons due to level placement.
- School is popular with business and medical professionals seeking accelerated and special vocabulary classes.
- Texts and materials are over \$15 per level.
- Class-hour is 55 minutes (Most universities use a 50 minute hour).
